#### OTHER SCHEDULING CONSIDERATIONS

- 1. Students must take an English, Math, Science, Social Studies, and Religious Studies course each year.
- 2. Course selections must equal 8 credits each year. Please note that some electives are .5 credit so two are needed to make a full credit.
- 3. Students must earn 1 Fine Art credit and 2 World Language credits (of the same language) to graduate.
- 4. Students must earn 2 Physical Education credits (HPE II is required) to graduate.
- 5. Many courses are required for TOPS and are indicated on the graduation planner.
- 6. AP classes *may* earn college credit if the student receives a 3, 4, or 5 on the AP exam.
- 7. English V DE and Sociology DE earn 3 hours of college credit. Spanish DE earns up to 6 hours of college credit.
- 8. Honors classes, English V DE, and Sociology DE receive a .5 extra credit, and AP classes and Spanish DE receive a 1.0 extra credit towards GPA.
- 9. Students will graduate with at least 30 credits depending on 8<sup>th</sup> grade classes.
- 10. Consult elective list for a full list of electives.
- 11. The Biomedics and Engineering PLTW programs consist of a four elective strand, one course taken each year 9<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup>. Courses taken beyond Principles of Biomedical Sciences and Introduction to Engineering Design earn .5 extra credit as Honors courses.
