



## 2021-2022 Tuition Assistance Application Process


We understand the choice of sending your child to Archbishop Hannan High School involves a significant commitment from the entire family; not the least of which is financial. As a Catholic school we strongly believe in doing whatever we can to assist families who might not otherwise be able to afford a Catholic education, as well those families experiencing temporary financial difficulties. Through a variety of funding sources, we were able to provide over \$285,000 in tuition assistance to qualified families during our most recent academic year.


Families may qualify for needs-based assistance by submitting an online application and supporting documentation to a third-party company who evaluates the application and recommends a tuition assistance award for qualified families. All needs-based assistance requests must follow this process to ensure a consistent and equitable distribution of funds to qualified families.

### Application Process – opens March 1, 2021

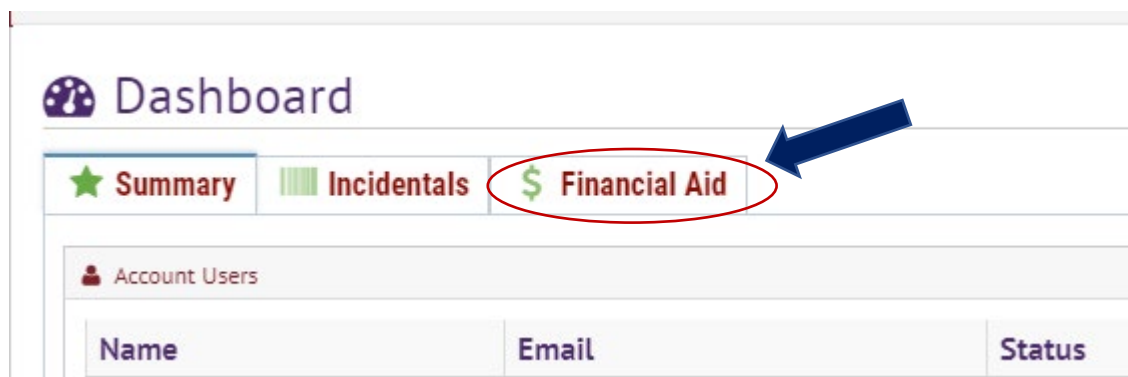

**Step 2 – After logging in, you will see “Dashboard.” Once there, click on the “Financial Aid” tab.**



**Step 3 – Select the first available link titled “Archdiocese of New Orleans Office of Catholic Schools” and apply for assistance through the Office of Catholic Schools (e.g. Champions of Catholic Education)**

Notes:

1. Applicants applying between March 1<sup>st</sup> and March 14<sup>th</sup> will be considered for assistance through both the Office of Catholic Schools and Archbishop Hannan High School (and will only pay one fee). These programs are independent of one another and it is possible that an applicant will qualify for assistance through one program without qualifying through the other program. Applicants will be notified separately from each program.
2. “Archbishop Hannan High School” will not be listed under the link titled “click here for school list” until the Archdiocesan application is removed.

**Step 4 – Complete the appropriate application and submit all necessary supporting documentation.**

Documentation Needed:

- Copy of most recently filed federal income tax return with all W-2s
- Copies of two (2) most recent paystubs for all applicants
- Copies of non-taxable income documentation (e.g. Social Security / Disability Income)
- Documentation of monthly rental expense (if applicable)
- Copy of court order(s) showing alimony, child support, or other financial agreements (if applicable)

## Application Timing

Applications may be submitted **between March 1, 2021 and March 14, 2021 to be considered for both the Champions of Catholic Education Program and Assistance from Archbishop Hannan High School.** Only applications submitted through First Bank and Trust may be considered for Tuition Assistance through Archbishop Hannan High School. Please note: other programs, such as ACE or Arete, may use different programs and families should comply with all application instructions from those vendors.
